











# STUDY TOUR TO THE CZECH REPUBLIC 12 to 20 October 2024

Study tour is organized in frame of the project "Green restoration of Ukraine: Sustainable recovery of war-affected regions" supported by the Transition Promotion Program of the Ministry of the Foreign Affairs of the Czech Republic. The participants will be representatives of communities (hromadas), municipalities and local civic initiatives. The program will be focused on practical examples of sustainable development of municipalities, specific ecological measures and projects, sharing the experiences of local action groups, financing projects and creating new partnerships between municipalities in the Czech Republic and Ukraine.

#### PRACTICAL INFORMATION

The study tour is jointly organized by Arnika and the team of the Clean Air for Ukraine programme. Travel expenses as well as accommodation, diet and secure travel insurance is covered by these organizations. Accommodation will be rather modest and in shared rooms.

During the study tour we will spend a lot of time outside, please be prepared for different weather (the agenda might change in case of extremely bad weather conditions). Recommended equipment: outdoor clothes including <u>rainproof</u> shoes and jacket/raincoat, water bottle, a small backpack for shorter trips, an umbrella.

The excursions will be in Czech or English always with interpretation to Ukrainian. Participants will arrive by train; within the Czech Republic we will travel by rented bus.

Hostětín is a small village with an unusual concentration of model ecological projects - a biomass heating plant with heat distribution system for 80% of households, a wastewater root (vegetation)











sewage treatment plant, two photovoltaic plants, a passive house of the community centre, a cider house with organic production, a historic fruit drying plant and sample natural garden and orchard.

In Sumice we will see an example of transformation of 75 hectares of intensively used agricultural landscape into floodplain forest, flowery meadow, ponds and wetlands. We will talk about the impact of this measure to biodiversity, soil quality, drought and flood protection but also recreation and the financial potential.
