Daniel Vondrouš: Influence of the EU standards on transparency and environment

environmental NGOs and as an assistant in Chamber of Deputies of the Parliament of the Czech Republic. In the years 2002–2010 and again from 2022, he worked as an adviser and head of advisers to seven

materials and waste management.

He acts as an advisor to the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development, Greenpeace, WWF, REC, IUCN and other organizations. He worked as an advisor to the European Parliament for acceding countries. In 2000-2002 he was an expert of the Ministry of the Environment for the Aarhus Convention.

Ondřej Pašek: Energy transition for the people: Involving households and municipalities He is a policy campaigner with Hnutí DUHA – Friends of the Earth, one of the most important environmental NGOs in the Czech Republic. He focuses on economic instruments promoting renewable energy and energy efficiency. His background comprises environmental studies, previous experience in NGOs focusing on climate change negotiations, and European public funding. Currently, Friends of the Earth and him are working on establishment of conditions for community energy and a joint NGO campaign providing energy poverty solutions to vulnerable households.

Jitka Seitlová: The current situation in Europe in relation to wartime Ukraine
Politician, geologist and expert on protection of environment. From 1996 to 2007 and again from 2014, she was a senator, from 2020 she was the deputy chair of the Senate of the Parliament of the Czech Republic, from 2000 to 2004 and again from 2016 she was a councillor of the Olomouc Region. Between 2007 and 2014, she worked as a deputy ombudsman. For a long time, she has been defending the right of the public to information and participation in decision-making on environmental matters. She was involved, for example, in the cases of illegal development buildings.
